Yankel Feather (1920 – 2009) was a member of the Liverpool Academy of Arts and the Newlyn Society of Artists. His lust for life, energy and drive resulted in a powerful, intriguing legacy of work.

Feather's paintings go beyond mere representation, depicting both movement and landscape in a delightful and engaging way.

Painting from memory, Feather depicted a wide variety of subjects; from Lowry inspired industrial scenes of his childhood in Liverpool, atmospheric seascapes from years spent in St Ives, to colourful canvases of dancer's jiving in ballrooms.

Feather's work has the charismatic flair of modernism at its best, painted with confident and uninhibited brush strokes. His canvases still dance with a joyous celebration of what it is to be alive, all the assimilation of a lifetime's experience in art.

This is the first solo exhibition of Yankel's work in 2015 and celebrates the launch of his book, 'Oh Yankel!' Which is available to order in hard and soft back.

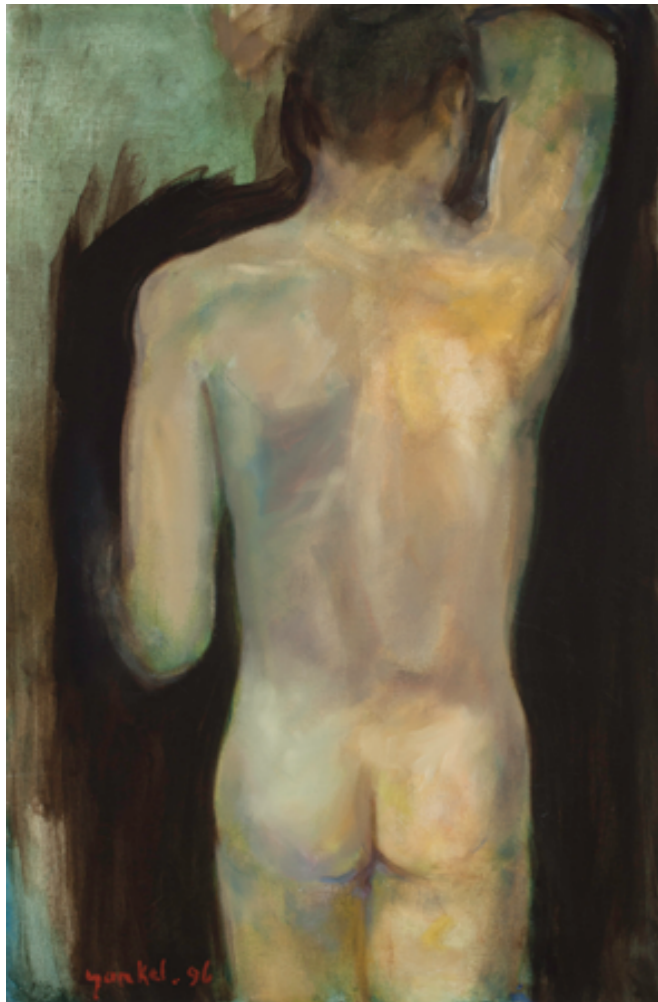

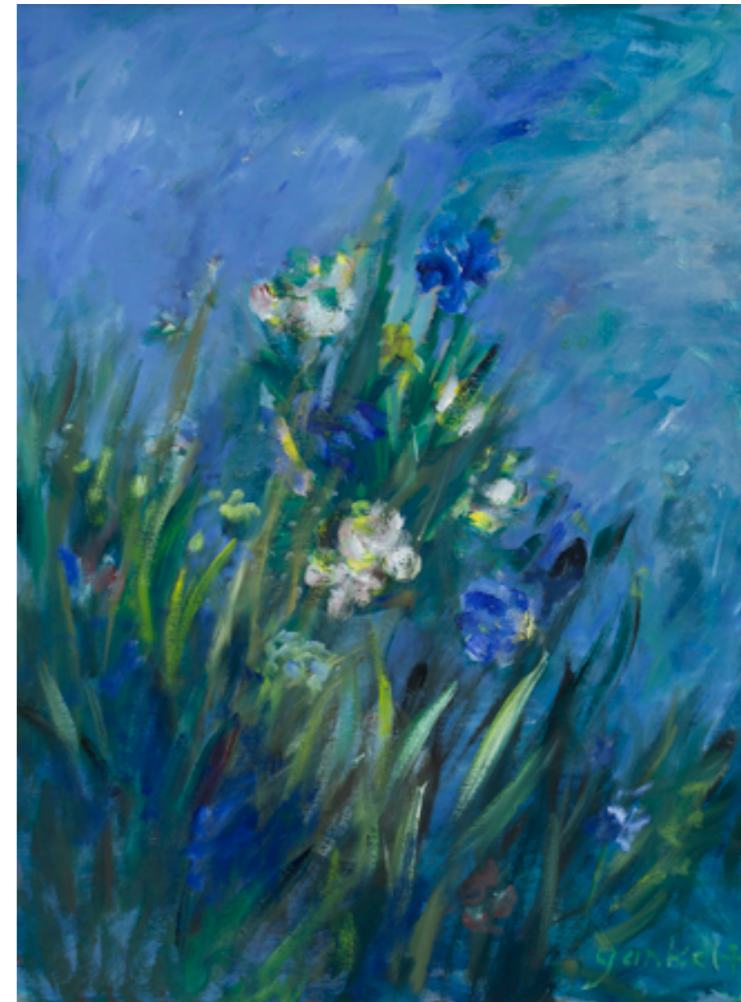

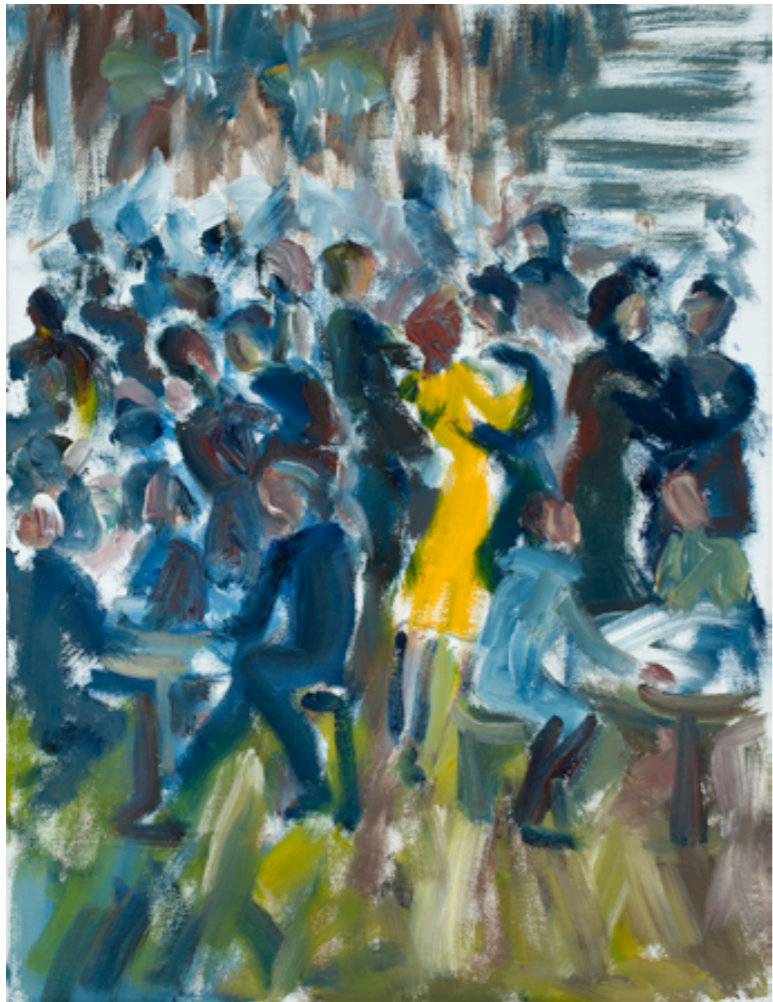
